

Port Community Advisory Committee Report 7/17/07

Air Quality Subcommittee - The most significant actions completed/events since 5/15/07 PCAC meeting include the following:

1. Continued discussion of Project proposals submitted for consideration under Air Quality Mitigation Program and agreed to request that the balance of Air Quality Mitigation Program funds of \$3,209,193 remaining for the AQMP Year 06-07 Cycle be released to fund the remainder of AQMP projects recommended by the Technical Advisory Committee.
2. Agreed to move request that Contracts with the two Consultants to the Air Quality Subcommittee be issued for no less than an 18-month term, rather than the three-month term as was the practice for the past six months.
3. Received update from Air Resources Board regarding ARB rules applicable to Auxiliary Marine Power at POLA/POLB.
4. Learned from POLA Staff that CAAP Truck Program is delayed for final consideration (and expected approval) by both Ports' Harbor Commissioners until September.
5. Identified concern that Health Risk Assessment under development in CAAP is based on emissions subsequent to July 05 PierPass implementation.
6. Agreed to request and obtain Consultants' assistance in development of Comments for submittal applicable to Air Quality Impacts in the Berths 136-147 (TraPac) EIR/EIS.
